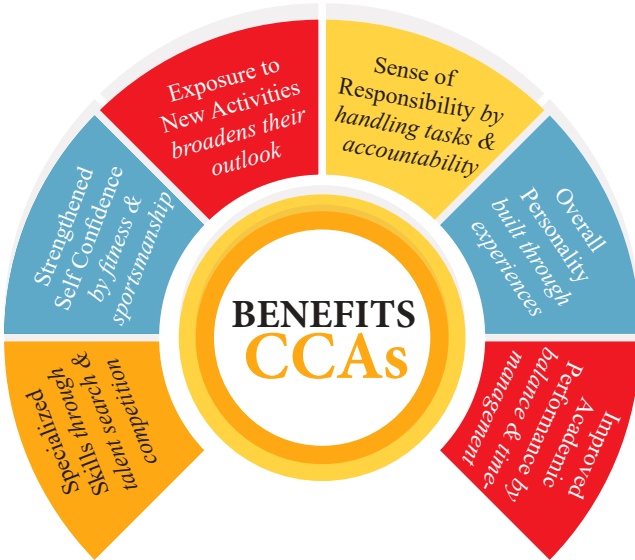
Expand Your Mind

Our publications are intended to support and activate student learning apart from disseminating knowledge to the student body at the College and in Nepal.

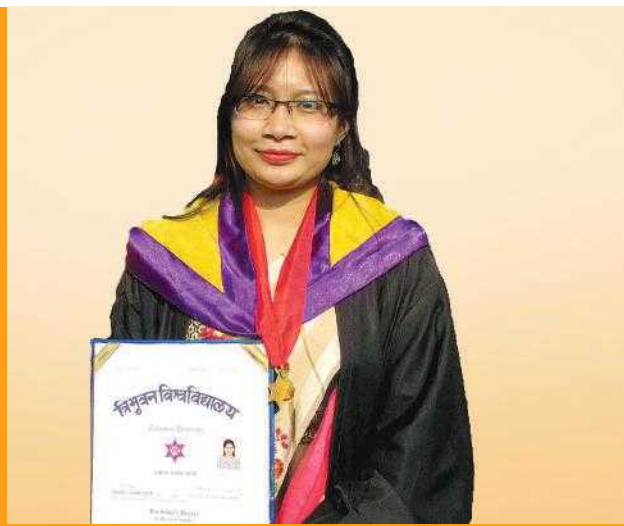
