Visit commercial banks or financial institutions in your area. Analyze and document their core functions, such as deposits, loans, and other financial services. Include relevant photos or images taken during your visit to complement and enrich your report.

*Note: Ensure your report is well-structured, with clear headings, detailed observations, and properly captioned visuals to effectively present your findings.*

## ACCOUNTING

### **Practical Work Guidelines and Instructions**

To develop practical skills in accounting, students are required to visit a local manufacturing company and collect data for analysis.

Follow the tasks and instructions below for each practical work carefully.

### **Practical Work: Material Management and Store Ledger Preparation**

**Objective:** Learn material purchasing procedures, pricing methods and store ledger preparation.

#### **Instructions:**

1. Visit a company that has an organized material management system.
2. Record the *name, address, and nature of business*.
3. Interact with the Storekeeper and gather details about the storekeeper, including *Name and Duties and responsibilities*
4. Learn about the company's Material Purchasing Procedures.
5. Attach or prepare the purchase requisition form used for purchasing.
6. Identify whether the company uses a *Perpetual* or *Periodic* inventory system.
7. Prepare a Store Ledger [*use at least 20 transactions during the month*] using any one of the methods (FIFO, LIFO, Weighted average or Moving average).
8. Include a photo of yourself at the company location.

## COMPUTER SCIENCE

1. Prepare a Project report providing a brief review of one of the e-commerce platforms operating in Nepal.

## HOTEL MANAGEMENT

1. Prepare a Project report on recipe and methods of preparation of any traditional dishes prepared in your home during Dashain-Tihar-Chhath vacation.

## BUSINESS STUDIES

1. Make a visit to an organization of your locality of your convenience established under the Nepal Company Act. Ask to the manager of the company about the decision-making process in that organization.

*Prepare a draft relating to the decision-making process.*

### **General Guidelines for Practical Work (Accounting, Economics, Hotel management, Business Studies and Computer Science):**

1. Ensure your report is original and based on actual data collected from the company/ place you visited.
2. Use proper formatting, including headings and numbering.
3. Reports must be typed with the given format.
4. Include all supporting documents and photographs.
5. Submit the completed practical work by the deadline provided.
6. **Acknowledgment:** Thank the company and individuals who helped you during the data collection or preparation process.
