Be Creative Creators

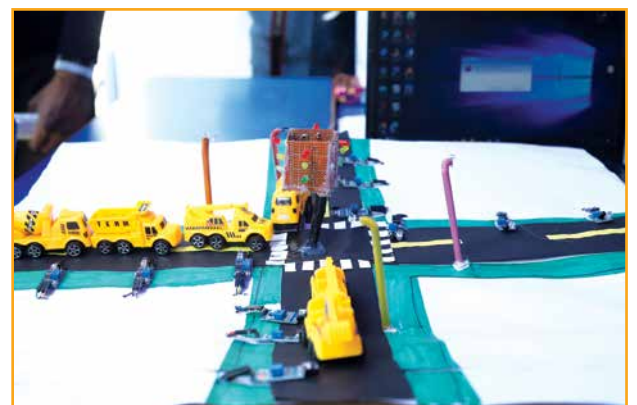

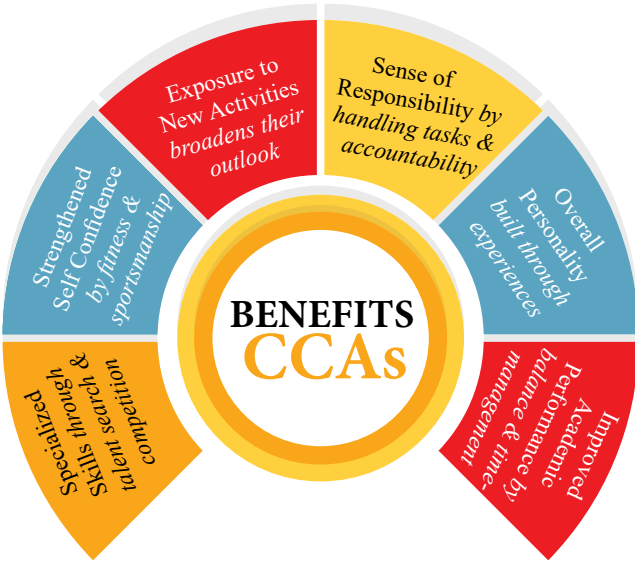
Expand Your Mind




Testimony
